

CABINETS Job Ready Checklist

This list is to be reviewed by the Builder/Superintendent to verify that the job site is ready for the Trade Contractor to arrive and begin work.

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	Permit card is clearly posted.
	Readable sign identifying the lot number is in place.
	Full accessibility to the site is established, including gravel pad or clear driveway.
	Silt fence is in place.
	Site is clear of trash and debris.
	The house is closed to outside elements.
	Stairs are installed per plan.
	Drywall has been installed and completed, including taping and texturing. Drywall has been primed,
	if required by Builder. Walls are square and plumb, with no more than 1/4" bow where cabinets will
	be installed.
	Interior trim has been completed.
	If ceiling is textured, ceiling work should be completed prior to cabinet installation.
	Trade Contractor has been notified of flooring styles. Flooring that should be installed prior to
	cabinets has been completed.
	Builder has notified the Trade Contractor of complete cabinet specifications for each room of the
	house, including cabinet style, color, location, size, etc. The opening for any appliance has been
	verified to meet the specifications for the required appliance. Cabinet specifications may include, bu
	are not limited to the following: cut outs, glass doors, trim, hardware, cabinet types, cabinet
	numbers, locations, bread boxes, cutlery drawers, pull out trash, tilt out tray, appliance model
_	numbers, color variations of cabinets, house trim specifications and heights of soffits or trim.
	Countertop surfaces have been selected.
	Downdraft vents, updraft vents and electrical conduits are in place for islands.

	dimensions based on window locations and wall measurements after drywall has been installed.

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ADDENDUM TO THE TRADE CONTACTOR AGREEMENT Scopes of Work - Cabinets

- Builder has verified the completion of the Job Ready Checklist for Cabinets.
- Perform all work within the guidelines specified by the contract, applicable building codes, manufacturer's specifications and the *Homeowner Handbook* (or applicable warranty program of the builder).
- All work to be completed in a manner that respects the efforts and materials of other Trades.
- After installation, cabinet tops may not be used for workbenches or to hold tools, materials or toolboxes.
 Damage to base cabinets is the responsibility of the Trade Contractor.
- Do not stand in sink basins.
- Before installing cabinets, verify that there is no damage, scratches, chips, etc. on the cabinets. Do not
 install damaged cabinetry.
- Verify all appliance dimensions. Be sure that there is enough room in the kitchen for the dishwasher
 and oven to open and close properly without interference. Drawers and cabinets open and close
 properly, without obstruction. Cabinets should include the necessary cutouts for sinks, range,
 dishwasher, refrigerator, vented hood, built-in microwave, etc.
- If flooring is installed after the cabinets, the height of the cabinets should be adjusted to compensate for the thickness of the flooring.
- All cabinets should be installed level, plumb and square within 1/8". Shimming is acceptable to reach this tolerance.
- All holes for plumbing pipes should be cut accurately and neatly. Hole should be of a size so that the proper escutcheon covers the hole. On average, the hole should be ½" larger than the pipe.
- Wall cabinets should be installed with at least two screws per stud, which penetrate each stud at least 2". Screws should be located at the top and bottom.
- Attach cabinets with #8 wood screws, square head.
- Cap all screw heads with covers, especially in glass front or white cabinets.
- When individual cabinets are joined together to form a group of cabinets, they should fit together snugly
 with no visible cracks or open joints. Cabinets should be connected together with at least two screws
 between each set of cabinets.

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Scopes of Work Continued - Cabinets

- Cabinet door or drawer warpage shall not exceed 1/8" as measured from the face frame to the point of furthermost warpage, with the door or drawer front in the closed position.
- Cabinet tops should be level within 3/8" in 10'.
- The gap between the cabinet and the wall should not exceed 1/8".
- The closing mechanisms for cabinet doors shall be adequate to hold the doors in a closed position.
- Cabinet shelves should be level. Shelf clips should be in the proper position.
- Cabinet faces should be flush and cabinet bottoms should be in line.
- Roller tracks for rollout shelves should be attached securely. The shelf should roll smoothly and not tilt
 when extended.
- Revolving shelves should be securely anchored at the top and bottom, with smooth operation and no tilt.
- Cabinet crown molding should be level and uniform in appearance.
- Hardware for the cabinetry should be attached with screws and set smooth with no damage to the interior of the cabinets.
- Verify that all parties understand color variations of the cabinets.
- Cabinets are clean inside and out.
- Island should be secured to the floor, if specified by the Builder. Coordinate with the Builder as to who should secure the island.
- Materials, trash, and construction debris shall be cleaned up and deposited in the designated area.

		Islands are properly secured to the floor, if specified by the Builder.	
		Cabinet shelves are level and free of damage.	
		Adjustable shelves rest securely on shelf holders. No shelf holders are missing or improperly	
		placed.	
		Screws attaching hardware have not splintered wood beyond the screw head or decorative	
		washer.	
		No hammer tracks are visible in the trim material.	
		Cabinet doors and drawers open and close with reasonable ease and without obstruction.	
		All cabinet doors operate properly, have an even reveal, do not swing open independently	
		and do not squeak.	
		All joints are flush with no gaps.	
		Rollout shelves operate smoothly and are tight and secure.
