

MIRRORS Job Ready Checklist

This list is to be reviewed by the Builder/Superintendent to verify that the job site is ready for the Trade Contractor to arrive and begin work.

		Permit card is clearly posted.		
		Readable sign identifying the lot number is in place.		
		Full accessibility to the site is established, including gravel pad or clear driveway.		
		Silt fence is in place.		
		Site is clear of trash and debris.		
		Walls on which mirrors will be installed have been primed, at a minimum.		
		No wallpaper has been installed under the location of the mirror.		
		Vanities and vanity tops have been installed and are level.		
		Electrical wires should exit drywall at least 45" high, from the top of the vanity, to clear the mirrors.		
		Verify that no walls are out of plumb beyond 1/4 inch over 6'.		
		Verify location, size, color, height, thickness and style of all mirrors with the Trade Contractor.		
		Check for any customer options. Verify any electrical outlets within the mirror.		
		An area has been designated for trash and debris collection.

ADDENDUM TO THE TRADE CONTRACTORS AGREEMENT Scopes of Work - Mirrors

This scope of work does not include mirrored doors, closet doors, or specialty mirrors.

- Builder has verified the completion of the Job Ready Checklist for Mirrors.
- Perform all work within the guidelines specified by the contract, applicable building codes,
 manufacturer's specifications and the *Homeowner Handbook* (or applicable warranty program of the builder).
- All work to be completed in a manner that respects the efforts and materials of other Trades.
- Verify the correct size, location, color, height, thickness and style of all mirrors with the Builder.
- Vanities may not be used for workbenches or to hold tools, materials or toolboxes. Damage to counter surfaces or base cabinets is the responsibility of the Trade Contractor.
- Damage to surrounding surfaces during the installation of the mirrors is unacceptable.
- Keep all mirror pieces and hardware out of drains.
- Notify Builder of any walls out of plumb greater than 1/4" in 6'.
- Do not cover any defective or inferior work.
- Install mirrors level, square and plumb, within 1/8" in 6 feet.
- Mirrors should not be installed if they are chipped, scratched, cracked or have any distortions or damage to the backing.
- Secure mirrors to the wall with mastic. Apply one golf ball sized application of mastic per square foot, or per mastic manufacturer's specifications.
- Backing on mirror should be dry and free of dust prior to application.
- Mirror reveal may range from $\frac{1}{2}$ "-1" unless specified otherwise by the Builder.
- Mirrors should be 40"-42" high unless otherwise specified by the Builder.
- Use ¼" thick mirrors unless specified by Builder.
- Mirror clips, when used, must comply with FHA/VA standards and securely mount to the wall.
- All mirror edges should be seamed or polished.
- Mirror should be properly centered over the bowl or vanity, per Builder specifications.
- Mirror plate covers should be installed over electrical outlets in the mirrors.
- Beveled trim should be attached with double stick tape or RTV silicone. Do not use acidic silicone.
- Materials, trash, and debris shall be cleaned up and deposited in the designated trash collection area.

MIRRORS Job Complete Checklist

This checklist is to be reviewed by both the Trade Contractor and the Builder/Superintendent to verify that the work has been completed according to the Scopes of Work.

Check box when complete **TRADE BUILDER** Size, color, location, height, thickness and style of all mirrors match the Builder's contract. No defective, chipped, cracked, distorted or broken mirrors are present. Mirror edges are seamed or polished with no damage. Mirror clips, if used, comply with FHA/VA standards and are securely mounted to the wall. Mirrors are level, square and plumb. Surfaces around the mirror have not been damaged. All drains are free of mirror pieces and hardware. Mastic has been wiped clean from all surfaces. Materials, trash and debris have been collected and deposited in the designated trash collection area.
